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





we're bumming drums and amp-cabinets at Gilman in the first place anyway. (fri and sun that weekend in SC and stockton, bum city saints are on the bills and our guaranteed equpment-loan/share for those gigs). (a 4-door rental car is our band's limit/budget on out-of-area trips and there's not a lot of a drum kit you can get into a Ford Taurus or whatever, after three guys/band down in LA get in).

set times:

we never book a headlining gig unless we're guaranteed 1 hour "stage time" counting or not counting changeover. NO EXCEPTIONS (see set list below). cause people get pissed when we don't play "their favorite song" etc. and we get blamed ( = me) not the venue. " oh just cut five songs out" hahaha that's like barely 6 minutes, doesn't even make a dent. the Warped Tour incalif gigs (four i think) that we have to play this year are 30-minute sets and we're gonna have to cut the LONGEST TWELVE songs out of our set to get it down close to 30 min. like 12 songs or more cut out of 34. yep, there's no way I'm In Love With Your Mom, I'm A Pig, etc get into a warped tour set.

it always takes 55 minutes to get the 34 or 35 songs done including the audience stuff which is the best part of any giq.

basically i'm sayin. if the stage isn't empty (of musicians, not the gear) at 11:15 for us to get on and play the proper 35 song set, all fucking hell will break loose. after 15 years of occasions where idiot 21+/bar owners (shut off the power early, and your set stops 10 songs early) or bands playing into our set time, i have zero patience left with those kind of snafus. cause i'm the guy back at the merch table who has to explain "why didn't you play Hitler Cock waaaaah i spent my allowance on gas money waaaaahh," sick of it.

counting audience participation as usual, the 34 songs (we lost one somewhere a year ago) take 55 min tops.

i stand corrected on the first point; jeff was singing the song until he left/quit/got fired/whatever and Todd took it over (and other singers, after that). the rest of that quote is NOT what happened after jeff was gone.

here is where the 14 tracks on Back From Samoa came from:

the only recording session with Jeff Dahl:

(1) "Marin County session" = Ballad of Jerry Curlan (the other 10+ songs recorded were a complete disaster, and all deemed unusable by gregg and todd) none of those songs (save Curlan) have ever turned up on bootleg: the tapes disappeared (along with all other Back From Samoa multi-tracks) into the band's 1981-82 manager Brian Izen's vaults.

after jeff has departed/quit/got fired/left/whatever --

- (2) MYSTIC craphole STUDIOS: Steak Knife, Lights Out, and They Saved Hitler's Cock (and the other three Queer Pills 7"ep tracks) (Lights Out and a rough mix w/Tod vocal of Steak Knife are sent to Takeit! zine and issued on the DK's nazi punks fuck off flexi-7"ep)
- (3) PIHRANA STUDIOS: My Old Man's A Fatso, Homo-Sexual, Haizman's Brain Is Calling 7 of the album's 14 tracks have now been recorded (and four of them get lead vocals put on later into 1982 by me, per todd/gregg's instruction)

at this point (the end of 1981) i officially "come back," and after the two City Recorder songs have been mixed (at Cherokee on late night downtime), buy out Brian Izen with a \$7,000 check roughly matching his recording/mixing/mixing costs of the above three sessions (dunno if a check for the City Recorders 2-song 5-hour session w/vocals was paid by brian or myself)

- (4) CITY RECORDERS: Gas Chamber, Not of This Earth (i'm there, and put the vocals on the minute the tracks are quickly cut)
- (5) QUAD-TECH: Time Has Come Today, Coffin Case, and re-recordings (since the Marin/Mystic/Mystic tracks are deemed "shitty sounding" which is correct) of Tuna Taco, You Stupid Jerk, and The Todd Killings.
- 1 + 3 + 3 + 2 + 5 = 14 album tracks from 5 different studios spread over almost 18 months' time.

i was never in the same room as the Marin tapes (cut with jeff); Tuna Taco (w/todd on lead vocals) was the only track that MIGHT have been mixed along with Ballad of Jerry Curlan, but gregg went out to Marin to supervise that himself.

turner has babbled gibberish (over the last 25 years since he was put on anti-depressant meds...that's a lot of Prozac) about everything related to the band since he disappeared from California in 1993. but Todd, PJ, and Billy have clear memories and can easily verify/recall the songs above matched with the studios -- the audio itself quite clearly identifies Shithole-A from Shithole-B and C and D and E.

i enjoyed typing this because now i have an official FAQ.

i posted a lot of random information (on the same topic) into herehttp://viewmorepics.myspace.com/index.cfm?fuseaction=viewIma ge&friendID=192503&albumID=1454910&imageID=66170723 last year. but this is a lot tidier

thank you mr sick-o-beater! fyi your band only sucks half a hard as the Clash! (mike A says there is a later Mentors record that is much better. i might be confusing the band's Enigma output with Mojo Nixon who never cut a single listenable track, musical word vomit).



Angry Samoans THE T.U.M.O.R.S. / Angry Samoans at Camarillo State Hospital on March 3, 1979

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CAMARILLO STATE HOSPITAL & THE T.U.M.O.R.S.

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The T.U.M.O.R.S. were the precursor to Hidden Agenda as you may have read in our little Bio. Sort of musical boot camp to learn the basics. Many musicians sought to go no further and that's fine for them. I saw my beloved peeps The Germs 6 months ago after 20 some odd years. Still tearing it up but with the film star replacing Darby.

I think there are pics of the original band The Germs we took here in My Pics on the Hidden Agenda myspace. If not they are on the War Kittens site. One features Belinda Carlisle of the Go Go's in her yellow Germs T-shirt. So much for name dropping.

As did several punk bands, we felt we had outgrown the thing that was punk after a couple years. Perhaps that brands us as never having been Real Punks in the first place. Whatever.

What the wanker journalists called Post Punk became 'the next thing' and we too moved on, to Hidden Agenda. But our time in The T.U.M.O.R.S. is still very memorable with the gigs being the best memories of all.

Walt writes about one of The T.U.M.O.R.S. most amazing gigs of all we did.

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Many bands have now played the infamous Camarillio State Hospital, in Camarillo, California. It's a mental institution. For some, it's sort of a sick joke. For others, they care about the poor folk that live there and seek to brighten one of their days.

For us it started out the former, but became the latter.

There was an outdoor 'performing area' for lack of better description, in later days for artists to come and do shows. I understand Pete Wilson had the facility closed in '96. Asshole. They were all basically turned out into the streets, unless they had rich family. Few apparently did. 30 million illegal aliens here and this is who Pete Wilson turns his back on. The very neediest of the needy. Nuff politics.

Anyway the usually docile medicated patients (they call them 'clients' today, more politically correct you understand) are led out into the yard and sit on the grass and enjoy the show. It's a very beautiful soft mountainous Californian dreamscape that one could easily bliss out with, medicated or not.

In 1977, Mark's mother, Audrey, worked in one of the most dangerous wards at the facility. It

was the clinically insane violent offenders section. They were not exactly criminals but were there for acts of violence against themselves, others, or cats and dogs, what-have-you. Mark's mother came home often enough with proof of this with bumps and bruises on her arms and legs. But she loved her job and felt affection for these unfortunate souls.

This was where the real NUTS went! What better place for a bunch of noisy fools to go wreak havoc. We thought it would be a good publicity stunt to play there. Punk bands at the time in So Cal were always finding crazy places to play for the publicity.

In this case, the venue was crazy. She received permission with the Floor MD in charge to arrange our (The Tumors) performance, along with The Angry Samoans, who our guitarist (P.J. Galligan) knew. We weren't sure where we would set up upon arrival, and much to our surprise, it was right in the ward in the middle of the room. We'd kinda hoped to have our backs against a wall or SOME thing!.

We were a bit creeped out at first. A winding series of halls and locked doors. Didn't much care for the slamming locking doors. Kinda felt like what a submariner might feel like when first boarding. There were just a couple of nurses to protect us from about 25 severely disturbed patients. And they were not the big black male One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest nurses. They were ordinary middle aged women. But they were NURSES. Nurses are tough cookies. They take no shit.

Oh well,we thought, if they can hang here we can too. It was the first trip inside Max Security for most of us. Thankfully, the clients all lined up for their medication as we did a quick sound check. We took this as good omen. Maybe we'd get out of here without hypodermic needles jabbed in our eyes after all. I mean, they WERE crazy. We were only Posers acting crazy.

Mark and Rod were hungry and got directions to the cafeteria. When they came back they were laughing their asses' off. I guess they were mistaken for new patients and were helped by the staff while going through the line.(MF - It was a damn good lunch too! Those 'clients' used to eat well) Apparently the staff explained to them what a fork was and they just played along like any good Punk would.

Soon it was time to start and things were about to get strange. We opened with "Mongoloid" by Devo. The Angry Samoans found this to be amusing, as did this huge black guy who started taking his clothes off right in front of us.I guess he pulled this stunt alot, cause' he had multible layers of clothes on, allowing the staff to stop him before he got to the Full Monty. As this excercise in poor taste continued we did some Ramones - Now I wanna Sniff Some Glue, and I Wanna Be Sedated, and New Rose by The Damned. Just a collection of greatest punk hits of the time generally. We included originals too such as the P.J. Galligan masterpiece Thorazine Shuffle. Ok, it was a kinda fast shuffle.

Next up was a guy we named "Dance Fever" He looked like the host of that show and he was doing all these wild disco moves while screaming "I'm a dancer"! And how could we forget the guy that laid down and put his head in the bass drum and slept like a baby. And folks, you have never seen a mosh pit like the one we witnessed. It was truly like the Rainbow Coalition. Only better behaved

However, my favorite audience member was this little old woman who was sitting in the corner rocking back and forth with her eyes' closed. When we finished, she approached us, crying, and said it was the most beautiful thing she had ever heard. We learned later from Mark's Ma she was nearly deaf. She probably felt the thump of the bass guitar and drums through the floor.

Mark's mother was beaming with pride and so was the supervising Doctor in charge of the floor. They looked happy if a bit taken aback about the effect our wild performance had on the clients. Like they say about physicians Do No Harm. We did no harm.

The Angry Samoans returned to L.A. and set up other "shows" there with Fear and other Punk and Hardcore bands. By this time, The Tumors ceased to exist. P.J Galligan joined The Angry Samoans, Rod Figueroa (China) joined Christian Death. Myself and Mark were in the early stages of forming Hidden Agenda.

But what started as a sort of joke became something very meaningful, at least to us. We came to make punk craziness and a mosh pit, and created something very different. Instead of being spat upon, they smiled and danced like we were the Greatful Dead. They were happy , friendly, talkative and full of questions about the equipment and music. We let a few of them plunk around on our instruments before tearing down, as the Angry Samoans set up their gear. I wish I had taped THAT shit.

It was sweet and we had an interesting feeling like a movie where the character changes from what he started out as. We changed a bit.

Every band has it's "most unusual gig " story, and that's ours.
