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





we're bumming drums and amp-cabinets at Gilman in the first place anyway. (fri and sun that weekend in SC and stockton, bum city saints are on the bills and our guaranteed equpment-loan/share for those gigs). (a 4-door rental car is our band's limit/budget on out-of-area trips and there's not a lot of a drum kit you can get into a Ford Taurus or whatever, after three guys/band down in LA get in).

set times:

we never book a headlining gig unless we're guaranteed 1 hour "stage time" counting or not counting changeover. NO EXCEPTIONS (see set list below). cause people get pissed when we don't play "their favorite song" etc. and we get blamed ( = me) not the venue. " oh just cut five songs out" hahaha that's like barely 6 minutes, doesn't even make a dent. the Warped Tour incalif gigs (four i think) that we have to play this year are 30-minute sets and we're gonna have to cut the LONGEST TWELVE songs out of our set to get it down close to 30 min. like 12 songs or more cut out of 34. yep, there's no way I'm In Love With Your Mom, I'm A Pig, etc get into a warped tour set.

it always takes 55 minutes to get the 34 or 35 songs done including the audience stuff which is the best part of any giq.

basically i'm sayin. if the stage isn't empty (of musicians, not the gear) at 11:15 for us to get on and play the proper 35 song set, all fucking hell will break loose. after 15 years of occasions where idiot 21+/bar owners (shut off the power early, and your set stops 10 songs early) or bands playing into our set time, i have zero patience left with those kind of snafus. cause i'm the guy back at the merch table who has to explain "why didn't you play Hitler Cock waaaaah i spent my allowance on gas money waaaaahh," sick of it.

counting audience participation as usual, the 34 songs (we lost one somewhere a year ago) take 55 min tops.

i stand corrected on the first point; jeff was singing the song until he left/quit/got fired/whatever and Todd took it over (and other singers, after that). the rest of that quote is NOT what happened after jeff was gone.

here is where the 14 tracks on Back From Samoa came from:

the only recording session with Jeff Dahl:

(1) "Marin County session" = Ballad of Jerry Curlan (the other 10+ songs recorded were a complete disaster, and all deemed unusable by gregg and todd) none of those songs (save Curlan) have ever turned up on bootleg: the tapes disappeared (along with all other Back From Samoa multi-tracks) into the band's 1981-82 manager Brian Izen's vaults.

after jeff has departed/quit/got fired/left/whatever --

- (2) MYSTIC craphole STUDIOS: Steak Knife, Lights Out, and They Saved Hitler's Cock (and the other three Queer Pills 7"ep tracks) (Lights Out and a rough mix w/Tod vocal of Steak Knife are sent to Takeit! zine and issued on the DK's nazi punks fuck off flexi-7"ep)
- (3) PIHRANA STUDIOS: My Old Man's A Fatso, Homo-Sexual, Haizman's Brain Is Calling 7 of the album's 14 tracks have now been recorded (and four of them get lead vocals put on later into 1982 by me, per todd/gregg's instruction)

at this point (the end of 1981) i officially "come back," and after the two City Recorder songs have been mixed (at Cherokee on late night downtime), buy out Brian Izen with a \$7,000 check roughly matching his recording/mixing/mixing costs of the above three sessions (dunno if a check for the City Recorders 2-song 5-hour session w/vocals was paid by brian or myself)

- (4) CITY RECORDERS: Gas Chamber, Not of This Earth (i'm there, and put the vocals on the minute the tracks are quickly cut)
- (5) QUAD-TECH: Time Has Come Today, Coffin Case, and re-recordings (since the Marin/Mystic/Mystic tracks are deemed "shitty sounding" which is correct) of Tuna Taco, You Stupid Jerk, and The Todd Killings.
- 1 + 3 + 3 + 2 + 5 = 14 album tracks from 5 different studios spread over almost 18 months' time.

i was never in the same room as the Marin tapes (cut with jeff); Tuna Taco (w/todd on lead vocals) was the only track that MIGHT have been mixed along with Ballad of Jerry Curlan, but gregg went out to Marin to supervise that himself.

turner has babbled gibberish (over the last 25 years since he was put on anti-depressant meds...that's a lot of Prozac) about everything related to the band since he disappeared from California in 1993. but Todd, PJ, and Billy have clear memories and can easily verify/recall the songs above matched with the studios -- the audio itself quite clearly identifies Shithole-A from Shithole-B and C and D and E.

i enjoyed typing this because now i have an official FAQ.

i posted a lot of random information (on the same topic) into herehttp://viewmorepics.myspace.com/index.cfm?fuseaction=viewIma ge&friendID=192503&albumID=1454910&imageID=66170723 last year. but this is a lot tidier

thank you mr sick-o-beater! fyi your band only sucks half a hard as the Clash! (mike A says there is a later Mentors record that is much better. i might be confusing the band's Enigma output with Mojo Nixon who never cut a single listenable track, musical word vomit).



The T.U.M.O.R.S. were the precursor to Hidden Agenda as you may have read in our little Bio. Sort of musical boot camp to learn the basics. Many musicians sought to go no further and that's fine for them. I saw my beloved peeps The Germs 6 months ago after 20 some odd years. Still tearing it up but with the film star replacing Darby.

I think there are pics of the original band The Germs we took here in My Pics on the Hidden Agenda myspace. If not they are on the War Kittens site. One features Belinda Carlisle of the Go Go's in her yellow Germs T-shirt. So much for name dropping.

As did several punk bands, we felt we had outgrown the thing that was punk after a couple years. Perhaps that brands us as never having been Real Punks in the first place. Whatever.

What the wanker journalists called Post Punk became 'the next thing' and we too moved on, to Hidden Agenda. But our time in The T.U.M.O.R.S. is still very memorable with the gigs being the best memories of all.

Walt writes about one of The T.U.M.O.R.S. most amazing gigs of all we did.

\_\_\_\_\_

Many bands have now played the infamous Camarillio State Hospital, in Camarillo, California. It's a mental institution. For some, it's sort of a sick joke. For others, they care about the poor folk that live there and seek to brighten one of their days.

For us it started out the former, but became the latter.

There was an outdoor 'performing area' for lack of better description, in later days for artists to come and do shows. I understand Pete Wilson had the facility closed in '96. Asshole. They were all basically turned out into the streets, unless they had rich family. Few apparently did. 30 million illegal aliens here and this is who Pete Wilson turns his back on. The very neediest of the needy. Nuff politics.

Anyway the usually docile medicated patients (they call them 'clients' today, more politically correct you understand) are led out into the yard and sit on the grass and enjoy the show. It's a very beautiful soft mountainous Californian dreamscape that one could easily bliss out with, medicated or not.

In 1977, Mark's mother, Audrey, worked in one of the most dangerous wards at the facility. It

was the clinically insane violent offenders section. They were not exactly criminals but were there for acts of violence against themselves, others, or cats and dogs, what-have-you. Mark's mother came home often enough with proof of this with bumps and bruises on her arms and legs. But she loved her job and felt affection for these unfortunate souls.

This was where the real NUTS went! What better place for a bunch of noisy fools to go wreak havoc. We thought it would be a good publicity stunt to play there. Punk bands at the time in So Cal were always finding crazy places to play for the publicity.

In this case, the venue was crazy. She received permission with the Floor MD in charge to arrange our (The Tumors) performance, along with The Angry Samoans, who our guitarist (P.J. Galligan) knew. We weren't sure where we would set up upon arrival, and much to our surprise, it was right in the ward in the middle of the room. We'd kinda hoped to have our backs against a wall or SOME thing!.

We were a bit creeped out at first. A winding series of halls and locked doors. Didn't much care for the slamming locking doors. Kinda felt like what a submariner might feel like when first boarding. There were just a couple of nurses to protect us from about 25 severely disturbed patients. And they were not the big black male One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest nurses. They were ordinary middle aged women. But they were NURSES. Nurses are tough cookies. They take no shit.

Oh well,we thought, if they can hang here we can too. It was the first trip inside Max Security for most of us. Thankfully, the clients all lined up for their medication as we did a quick sound check. We took this as good omen. Maybe we'd get out of here without hypodermic needles jabbed in our eyes after all. I mean, they WERE crazy. We were only Posers acting crazy.

Mark and Rod were hungry and got directions to the cafeteria. When they came back they were laughing their asses' off. I guess they were mistaken for new patients and were helped by the staff while going through the line.(MF - It was a damn good lunch too! Those 'clients' used to eat well) Apparently the staff explained to them what a fork was and they just played along like any good Punk would.

Soon it was time to start and things were about to get strange. We opened with "Mongoloid" by Devo. The Angry Samoans found this to be amusing, as did this huge black guy who started taking his clothes off right in front of us.I guess he pulled this stunt alot, cause' he had multible layers of clothes on, allowing the staff to stop him before he got to the Full Monty. As this excercise in poor taste continued we did some Ramones - Now I wanna Sniff Some Glue, and I Wanna Be Sedated, and New Rose by The Damned. Just a collection of greatest punk hits of the time generally. We included originals too such as the P.J. Galligan masterpiece Thorazine Shuffle. Ok, it was a kinda fast shuffle.

Next up was a guy we named "Dance Fever" He looked like the host of that show and he was doing all these wild disco moves while screaming "I'm a dancer"! And how could we forget the guy that laid down and put his head in the bass drum and slept like a baby. And folks, you have never seen a mosh pit like the one we witnessed. It was truly like the Rainbow Coalition. Only better behaved

However, my favorite audience member was this little old woman who was sitting in the corner rocking back and forth with her eyes' closed. When we finished, she approached us, crying, and said it was the most beautiful thing she had ever heard. We learned later from Mark's Ma she was nearly deaf. She probably felt the thump of the bass guitar and drums through the floor.

Mark's mother was beaming with pride and so was the supervising Doctor in charge of the floor. They looked happy if a bit taken aback about the effect our wild performance had on the clients. Like they say about physicians Do No Harm. We did no harm.

The Angry Samoans returned to L.A. and set up other "shows" there with Fear and other Punk and Hardcore bands. By this time, The Tumors ceased to exist. P.J Galligan joined The Angry Samoans, Rod Figueroa (China) joined Christian Death. Myself and Mark were in the early stages of forming Hidden Agenda.

But what started as a sort of joke became something very meaningful, at least to us. We came to make punk craziness and a mosh pit, and created something very different. Instead of being spat upon, they smiled and danced like we were the Greatful Dead. They were happy , friendly, talkative and full of questions about the equipment and music. We let a few of them plunk around on our instruments before tearing down, as the Angry Samoans set up their gear. I wish I had taped THAT shit.

It was sweet and we had an interesting feeling like a movie where the character changes from what he started out as. We changed a bit.



## **Parasites Like Me**

# The Angry Samoans darkest secret

The Angry Samoans are good shit to skate to, seethe at your parents to, or just roil around in the testosterone-addled throes of puberty to. We're all agreed on that. But don't start thinking about them. Keep telling yourself that they're just another dumb—very dumb—old punk band. And if you're a music writer, don't start writing about them. Because they set booby traps.

Scissor and scalpel your way through all the sneering and juvenilia, through the wall-of-fuzz guitars and that marching-band stomp-stomp drumbeat, through 20 years of breakups and breakdowns and legends gone totally sour, and what do you find? Not a streets-of-Hollywood punk, not a skate rat gone bad, not a slumming rich boy . . . no, worse than that: you find another music writer just like you, pointing up from the abyss and laughing his ass off.

Because maybe you don't know this about the Angry Samoans. If you're a big Angry Samoans fan, if you hate everything they did after the *Back From Samoa* LP (and rightfully so) but still drag yourself out to see the resurrected Metal Mike and the Angry Samoan Jamboroo every couple of months or so, maybe you don't know who these guys were. Because they weren't really yours. They weren't disaffected teens articulating their all-consuming, adolescent alienation the only gosh-darn way they knew how. They were ours. Rock writers. Music journalists. Critics. Outsiders.

Parasites. Scum. Just like me. If there's a darker secret to the band, I can't imagine it.

So first there was VOM, the egregiously contrived pre-Samoan outfit: future Samoans and current/previous music critics Metal Mike Saunders on guitar/vocals and Gregg Turner on guitar. (Bill Vockeroth remains on drums.) Mike's curriculum vitae: started out with unpaid record reviews in *Rolling Stone* at 16, may have coined the term "heavy metal" during college stints for *Creem*, dropped out of rock journalism in 1973, and ended up in LA in punk rock 1978 as a 26-year-old accountant or something. Turner apparently wrote for the same esteemed publications but never granted an interview with RockCritics.com like Mr. Mike, so his past remains comfortably dim. The important thing is that these guys came to punk already bleary with experience, unlike the Neanderthals that lurched out of most suburban garages.

And speaking of lurching, VOM's most notorious member was Übercritic Richard Meltzer—I don't know exactly why he was notorious; I was about, um, zero years old at the time—and under his gentle hand, VOM was supposed to be a snotty goose to the ass to snooty LA punk. Problem was they were so funny ("I got my fingers in you, babe, but I wish they were in your mom!") everyone forgot to laugh. Why make a punk band to make fun of punk bands, asked ever-astute *Slash* magazine writer Claude Bessy, when every punk band by definition already made fun of itself? Why parody self-parody? Well, post-punk, it was the last forbidden territory—biting the hand that feedbacks you—and nothing's as finger-lickin' good as forbidden territory. When VOM whimpered out, Saunders, Turner and the new Angry Samoans dove into this heart of darkness face first. It's hard to tell if it killed them or made them stronger.

See, this was living life deep behind the irony curtain. Joke doesn't do it justice: the Angry Samoans were characters (and by characters I mean total assholes), slinging around "fag" and "queer" and bullshit like that so vociferously (most crucially in reference to poor old Catholic-schoolgirllovin' KROQ DJ Rodney Bingenheimer) that people like fucking Lee Ving were sitting them down and giving them stern talkings-to. All the uptight trendy punkers are pissed—mission accomplished, right? Because they didn't really mean it, right? They were just being, you know, "punk," right?

But then all these crazy kids from the suburbs started taking it really seriously—coming up to Rodney and monotoning, "In the name of the Angry Samoans, I'm going to kill you!" They'd play their song "Lights Out," and—as per lyrics—fans would mock-stab themselves in the eyes with plastic forks. Where's the joke now? On them? On the kids? On us? And then they made a classic record (the aforementioned *Back From Samoa*), but did they mean to? Most vitally, when and how does faking fake become real?

Fuck, as they say, if I know. I try not to think about it. Personality crises aside, it probably helped break up the band: these music-critic nerds were swept up in a pimple-faced, suburban, rock tornado of their own ill-advised making, and eventually maybe even they couldn't tell if it was a joke anymore. But everyone kept laughing anyway. Now that Mike has put together a new version of the Angry Samoans, it's even more convoluted. I hate to resort to critic-speak—believe me, I'm punching myself in the face right now as I type one-handed—but the Angry Samoans are a postmodern shitstorm from hell. Lies, truth, image, pose, substance, spectacle, impenetrable pundits like Lacan and our own Derrida—it's all a morass and a half. So don't try to think about them, and just let the music kill your brain. They still sound pretty good, and they play all the old stuff. It's just like the real thing. I think.

#### The History Book on the Shelf

#### n ABBA's "On And

On And On" the singer's at a party and gets into a conversation with someone who's worried about the world. He turns out to be a Swedish government minister and shouldn't really be saying that stuff (so they sing a stomping Beach Boys pastiche instead). Like a lot of ABBA's more rocking songs it doesn't quite work but fails in an endearing way-- but beyond that it struck me as an odd thing to be singing about.

I'm sure that in 1980 the band were something like royalty in Sweden and almost certainly were really going to dinner parties and meeting ministers. It's the matter-of-fact way they mention it that surprised me. I can only think of one other song about meeting a politician at a party-- Pulp's "Cocaine Socialism". The Pulp song takes the meeting as a springboard for a savage attack on Tony Blair's Labour Party, as well as Cool Britannia and cocaine and corruption. "Cocaine Socialism" is a fine record but it never struck me as odd-- biting outsider opposition was the tone I expected a record about politicians at parties to take. As opposed to ABBA's convivial reasonableness.

Of course I go to dinner parties sometimes myself, and though there aren't any politicians involved convivial reasonableness seems a fine aim. Maybe that's a reason I find myself enjoying ABBA more the older I get. Actually I can't remember not enjoying them: They were my favorite band at seven; they're one of my favorite bands at 34. What I want to explore in this column, though, is how ABBA often seem a very adult band, writing songs squarely set in the adult (as opposed to adolescent or teenage or college-age) world, coping with adult emotions, and particularly adult compromises and disappointments.

I'll admit I'm talking here mostly about the later ABBA, roughly from 1976's *Arrival* onwards. The earlier, goofier ABBA is also terrific-- and was the version that launched Europop as we knew it (try Holland's Luv' for a marvelous band that uses the ABBA of "King Kong Song" and "Ring Ring" as a springboard). I don't find myself feeling the songs as much as their later records, though, possibly because I think Bjorn Ulvaeus and Benny Andersson are excellent lyricists and on the earlier albums their confidence in their English wasn't up to showing that.

Critical wisdom has it that ABBA material darkened in the late 1970s because the two couples who formed the band both split up. There's surely a lot of truth in this— their later albums are studded with fantastic, rueful break-up songs— but I don't necessarily want to confuse "adult" and "dark" here. ABBA songs aren't "dark" just because of the intra-band divorces, they're more universal than that: the sorrow in them is often a sense that the best of times, the most lived parts of life, have already, irretrievably happened. "Having the time of your life"— the chorus of "Dancing Queen" is literally and painfully felt: this is as good as it gets. In so many ABBA songs the important stuff has all happened in the past— when Chiquita was sure of herself, when Fernando crossed the Rio Grande, when the narrators of "One Of Us" or "Thank You For The Music" made the decisions they're looking back on in the songs.

And what happens afterward? "Now you're working in a bank, a family man, a football fan, and your name is Harry."— this from "Our Last Summer", a relatively jolly song about lost first love that still fits in "a fear of getting old, a fear of slowly dying". Fears come true: dreams don't. But one of the things that makes ABBA adult rather than adolescent is that they're usually sympathetic to their fading everymen protagonists. Harry may just be a bank clerk but his life isn't horrible or wrong or a betrayal, it's just a bit more boring than it once was. "Should I Laugh Or Cry", a portrait by his tired, frustrated wife of an absurd domestic Napoleon, is probably the saddest record ABBA ever made but even this pathetic individual, shouting in too-short trousers. is no monster.

Compare, if you like, the ridiculous paroxysms of agony and disgust a band like Radiohead go through contemplating the simplest of socializations on "Fitter, Happier" or "Paranoid Android". ABBA understand and will not condemn compromise, and contentment, and dull satisfaction, and the flipside to the songs where they lament past excitement are the songs in which something immense does disrupt the adult world and its settlements. "Lay All Your Love On Me"-- not by accident the most irresistibly physical of any ABBA track-- spells it out: "a grown up woman should never fall so easily". On "The Visitors", set in a Soviet-occupied country, the European bourgeois world the band generally document becomes a terrified but precious pretense, one that can be shattered by a strangers' hand rattling the doorknob.

Strangest and maybe best of all is "The Day Before You Came", a simple portrait of an ordinary adult life on the day before it is changed forever: By what, we never learn. As the UK journalist Taylor Parkes notes in his fantastic 1995 essay on ABBA, the spectral choirs of backing vocals suggest a murderer as much as a lover. Here is the central ABBA theme: life is trivial and nothing happens, but the somethings that might happen are worse.

"The Day Before You Came" is full of awkward conversational lyrics: "I must have gone to lunch, at half past 12 or so, the usual place, the usual bunch". Their slight stiltedness is what makes ABBA great lyricists— as non-native speakers they rarely risked too many metaphors or much poetic imagery, preferring a matter-of-fact reportage of feeling. Combined with Agnetha and Frida's occasionally halting pronunciation this could make them sound devastatingly direct and vulnerable.

Sometimes ABBA could be high-falutin', though: "Happy New Year" has a death's head lyric which pins down the essential horrid sameness of January 1st and concludes that "man is a fool and he thinks he'll be OK, dragging on feet of clay, never knowing he's astray". Of course "Happy New Year" also has a chorus that goes "Happy New Year! Happy New Year!" and ABBA were a band that didn't know how not to write a catchy song, so it has a use-value that fights against its bleakness— thank goodness, or it would just be a moan. Because of the sheer sticking power of ABBA's melodies their lyrics can often be safely ignored— in a pub quiz once I asked teams to identify a verse from "Knowing Me, Knowing You"— "In these old familiar rooms, children once played. Now there's only emptiness, nothing to say". The song is one of the band's most famous in Britain, but nobody got it right.

In other words, ABBA's adultness, or darkness, is mostly strictly optional. In the same way as their characters lead well-ordered lives while suffering the occasional regret and pang of anxiety, ABBA never let their existential worries get in the way of their day job: writing immediately fabulous pop music. "The Visitors" may be about political paranoia but it's also got a blazing synthpop chorus. "The Day Before You Came" makes the rare move of putting its music where its mentality is and was one of the band's first flops.

Sometimes ABBA's musical instincts seem to sabotage the band's emotional impulses. "Our Last Summer" sticks to your head as doggedly as any of the band's hits until its bittersweet mood is jarred by a really downright vulgar guitar solo. Even this fits the mood, though. Then we were Summer heroes, it seems to be saying, now we're grown-up and awkward and the kind of basically not very cool people who think this song could use a bit of ill-placed axe work. Which is fine-- when the band did try and be fashionable (their recording jaunt to Miami at the mainstream height of disco, for instance) the results were even more inelegant than usual.

As a fan, I indulge ABBA's sometime musical inelegance as much as I enjoy their terrific songcraft, but what I keep coming back for is the sadness and richness in their songs. I've concentrated here on the lyrics because I think they're undervalued, but in the end the hooks are always going to be what sells ABBA, and this is probably as it should be. If you're fond of their hits at all though, keep their

records around, sniff about their back catalog a little more, and don't dismiss them: You may find that your life ends up more like an ABBA song than you imagine.

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
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
